



TESORA PRODUCT CARE & MAINTENANCE

Congratulations on the purchase of your Tesora Quartz countertop. Tesora Quartz is a beautiful, durable and resilient countertop surface that will provide you with many years of trouble-free performance. Maintaining your Tesora Quartz is simple and easy.

- For every day cleaning use a soft sponge or dishcloth with soap and warm water.
- For stubborn or greasy clean-ups use a gentle liquid cleaner like Mr. Clean, 409, Simple Green, Fantastic etc. or ordinary dish washing detergent (Dawn with warm water and soft sponge).
- Never use red or green Scotch Brite on Tesora Quartz as they contain aluminum oxide (the same abrasive in sandpaper) and may dull the finish.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning agents such as regular Comet and Ajax.
- Though most common household cleaners have no effect of Tesora Quartz, never allow your Tesora Quartz countertop to come in contact with drain cleaners, paint strippers or products containing Hydrofluoric acid, Methylene chloride, Trichloroethylene or any product with a very high or very low PH. These types of chemicals may etch or discolor the surface of Tesora Quartz.
- There is no need to seal your Tesora Quartz countertop. Sealers cannot penetrate Tesora Quartz and remain on the surface. Eventually the sealer will start to wear off unevenly in high use areas causing the polish to appear inconsistent.
- Tesora Quartz is scorch resistant and under normal conditions is not affected. Always use a trivet or hot pad between Tesora Quartz and any heat generating device including but not limited to air fryers, crock pots, deep fryers, hot pots and pans or electric skillets. Sudden or rapid change of temperature or sustained heating especially near edges and cut outs, may create enough thermal expansion energy to cause your countertop to crack. Damage caused by thermal expansion is not covered under the Tesora Quartz warranty.
- Quartz is a very hard durable surface designed to withstand normal use. While it is resistant to scratches, cuts, and chipping, cutting directly on Quartz should be avoided. Use of cutting boards and taking care not to drop or slide heavy objects on the surface will help to ensure the long lasting beauty of your Tesora Quartz.
